Morning

- (1) Metoprolol Tartrate, ¼ of 50mg tablet
- (2) Aspirin, 81mg, enteric coated
- (3) Warfarin (Coumadin) NA(?), 1mg. I take 3 (mistakenly written as "5" in my May 28, 2004, letter to you) tablets for five days and 2 ½ tablets for two days each week. My present INA(?) or blood anticoagulant level is 2.9

Evening


- (1) Metoprolol Tartrate, ¼ of 50mg tablet
- (2) Simvastatin, ½ of 40mg tablet
- (3) Tamsulosin HCL, 2 of .4mg tablets

As needed

- (1) Lorazepam, .5mg tablet (I am taking 1 to 2 tablets a day now)

Would you please send me a 90 day supply of the above? If not, would you please tell me why? Running out of medicine is an unnecessary stress.
